At ACE Scholarships, we believe every child deserves a quality education. We are committed to making that a reality by offering partial tuition scholarships to K-12 students.

WHAT CAN ACE DO FOR MY CHILD?

With a partial tuition scholarship from ACE, your child may attend the private school of your choice – opening the door for a great education.

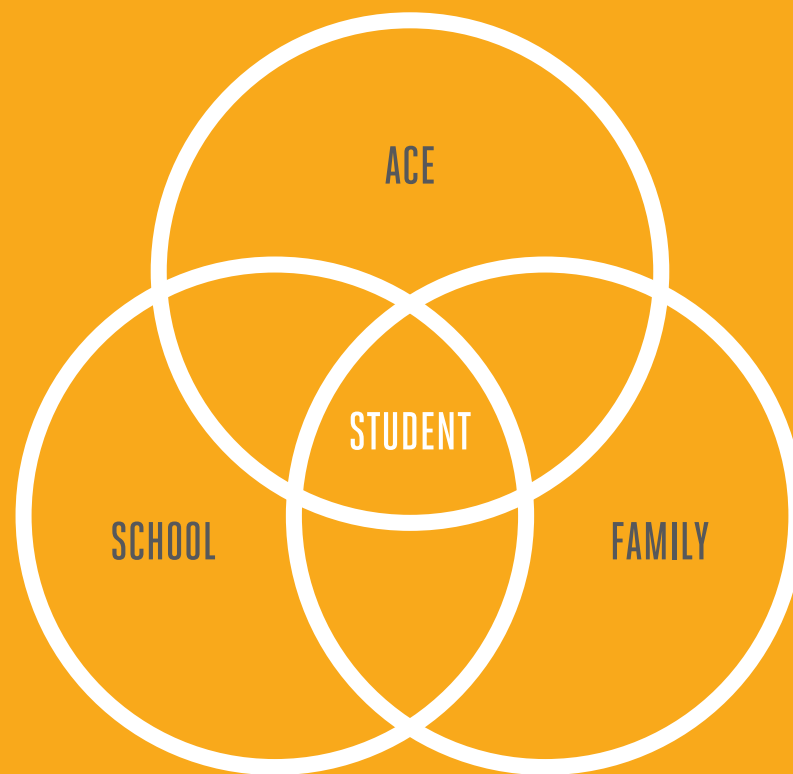
HOW DOES ACE WORK?

ACE provides financial support for qualifying students at our partner schools. Scholarships are distributed to schools quarterly.

ACE: A PARTNERSHIP

ACE Scholarships will pay \$4,200 per year for grades K-8 and \$4,500 per year for grades 9-12.

Families are responsible for working out a payment plan with the school for the remainder of the tuition – creating a three-way model in which ACE Scholarships, the partner school, and the family are all invested in the child's success.



WHERE ARE ACE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE?

ACE currently offers scholarships in eight states: Arkansas, Colorado, Kansas, Louisiana, Missouri, Montana, Texas (Dallas/Fort Worth, Houston, and San Antonio), and Wyoming.
