

WHO WE ARE

Our vision is that every child has access to a quality education. Since 2000, ACE has provided more than 80,000 scholarships to children from lower-income families totaling over \$212 million and established partnerships with over 1,000 private schools across the country. Since launching in Louisiana in 2014, ACE families have accepted more than 13,800 scholarships totaling nearly \$59 million. ACE Scholarships has also established partnerships with 194 partner schools throughout the state.

WHAT WE DO

ACE offers partial tuition scholarships to students from lower-income families so they may attend the private school of their choice. The ACE scholarship follows the child throughout their K-12 education.

Does my child qualify for a scholarship?

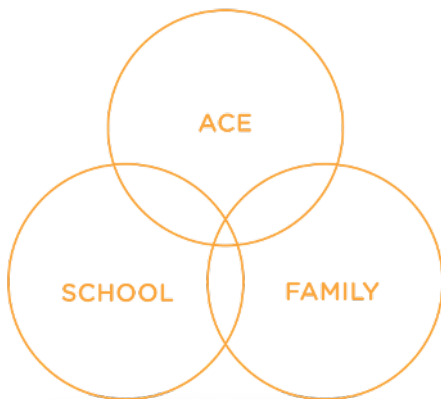
Eligibility is based on family income and prior school enrollment. See the chart for ACE Scholarships financial eligibility. Additionally, students must either be: entering kindergarten for the first time, enrolled in a LA public school, or awarded a scholarship at a nonpublic school the prior year. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis with priority on returning students and students currently awarded through the Louisiana Scholarship Program.

How much are the scholarships?

ACE Scholarships are partial tuition, intended to provide added assistance lower-income families may need to enroll their child in a private school. Standard ACE award amounts are approximately \$4,200 for K-8th and \$4,500 for high school. Families are responsible for working out a payment plan with the school for the remainder of the tuition.

Which schools participate?

A wide variety of private schools partner with ACE Scholarships. It is up to the families of potential scholarship recipients to select the best school for their child. To see a complete list of schools in Louisiana, please visit our website. Don't see your private school choice on our list? Reach out to us to inquire about partnering with ACE.

The ACE scholarship can follow your child.

ACE Scholarships follow the student. If a student is awarded an ACE scholarship, those funds are portable and may be used at any ACE Scholarships partner school. So, if the private school selected ends up not being the right fit, the child can transfer to another partner school, and the scholarship goes with them.

How do I apply?

The application for an ACE scholarship is completed on a website called FACTS, at the link and QR code below.

For families new to the scholarship opportunity:

1. Confirm that you qualify for an ACE scholarship based on the financial guidelines listed in the chart on the previous page.
2. Identify the right ACE partner private school for your child.
3. Complete the school's application and enrollment process for your child. If the school you are applying to also uses FACTS for their school application, you can use your same FACTS login to apply to ACE. If the school you are applying to does not use FACTS for their school application, you will create a FACTS log-in. You will need to create an application for ACE Scholarships, separate from your school application.
4. Ensure that your application is complete, including supporting documents, and submit!

You will be routed to either ACE or FACTS depending on the nature of your question.

The application will be open from Monday, February 5th through Monday, April 15th at 11:59 PM (in the time zone in which the school you are applying with resides).

For families already receiving the scholarship:

- *It is imperative that the application is submitted and complete in order for your child to remain on scholarship.
1. Complete the school's application and enrollment process for your child. If the school you are applying to also uses FACTS for their school application, you can use your same FACTS login to apply to ACE. If the school you are applying to does not use FACTS for their school application, you will create a FACTS log-in. You will need to create an application for ACE Scholarships, separate from your school application.
 2. Ensure that your application is complete, including supporting documents, and submit!
